Japanese tea is deeply ingrained in the lives and culture of Japanese people. There are countless words in Japanese with the word tea (cha) in it, such as cha-no-ma (literally, "space for tea"), which refers to the living room—the main room of the house where the entire family gathers, and cha-nomitomodachi (literally, "friend that you drink tea with"), which means a close friend. Many sayings and superstitions in Japan involve tea as well. For example, it is said to be a sign of good luck to have a tea stalk floating upright in your tea. Understanding and experiencing tea is one of the most important keys for learning about Japanese culture.
